

CLUB INFORMATION  
on the  
ARARAT FLYING FEZ CLUB

MEETINGS: Flying Fez meetings are held at the Temple the 2nd Monday of the month at 7:30 p.m.

DUES: Flying Fez dues are \$15.00 per year. All dues are due by January 31 of the New Year.

All members dues are due at the same time and not pro-rated regardless of when they originally joined the club.

INITIATION FEE:

Flying Fez initiation dues are \$50.00 which is for uniform pieces a new member receives, plus not being required to pay the yearly dues of \$15.00 if he joins after Dec. 31. This system enacted to keep from pro-rating the \$15.00 dues and in keeping with the By-laws which state "All members dues will come due by Dec. 31 and delinquent Jan. 31.

WINGS:

All Flying Fez members are entitled to and urged to wear the Gold Flying Fez Wings and the Gold and Black name identification Badge, as per uniform code; for further identification, have the club name "Flying Fez" sewn across the front of the Fez; also to wear Epaulet Stripes as outlined under "Epaulet identification". (see page 2)

UNIFORMS

DRESS CODE: Summer- White open collar shirt with epaulets and epaulet shoulder stripes of Gold and Black.

- . Wings over left pocket of shirt
- . Name plate over right pocket of shirt
- . Grey Trousers
- . Fez headgear

UNIFORMS

DRESS CODE: Winter- White shirt (closed collar with tie) (optional - epaulet stripes on shirt) under coat. (You could wear a regular white dress shirt).

- . Maroon Tie
- . Dark Blue Sport Coat (brass buttons optional)
- . Wings over left pocket of coat
- . Name plate under wings of the same left pocket. (Placing both together on the left is necessary because there is no right pocket on coats)
- . Grey trousers
- . Fez headgear

IN FLIGHT

UNIFORM: Flying Fez Silver jacket can be worn in place of Blue Coat, tie optional in flight.  
(A new Flight jacket with breast pockets in dark blue as a Flight uniform piece is in the making at this time).

SHOULDER:

EPAULET STRIPES

IDENTIFICATION:

(TWO) 2 - Gold Stripes - Crew or ground support.

(THREE) 3 - Gold Stripes - Any club member holding a pilot's license previously valid or current.

(FOUR) 4 - Gold Stripes - Any club member holding a valid Pilot's license, with IFR rating, meeting the insurance qualifications and has been checked out by the chief pilot, or his designee authorizing him to make hospital flights.

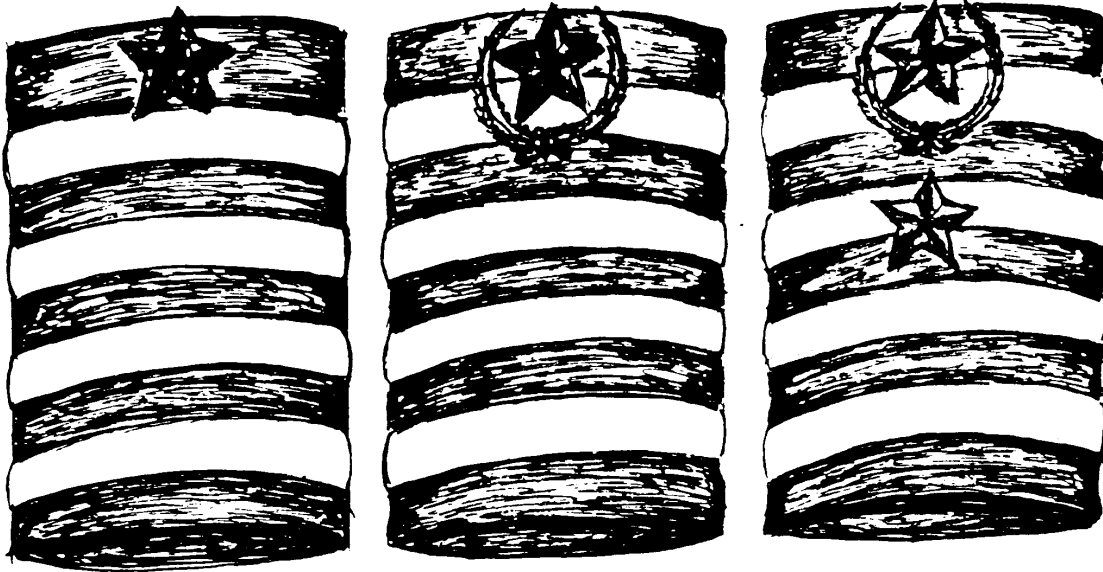

ALL GOLD STAR AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED BY THE POTENTATE

AWARDS: The Flying Fez Club throughout the years has established the following awards-  
Flying Fez "Eagle Wings": The highest honor possible to bestow on a Club Member, awarded only when merited, not necessarily an annual award.

Flying Fez "Man of the Year": The highest yearly honor possible to bestow on a member in recognition of his outstanding performance and excess devotion and dedication to the Flying Fez cause and responsibilities through out the year.

Flying Fez "Most Perfect Attendance Award": An annual award presented to the member who prioritized his time to attend the most meetings throughout the year.

(The Awards Committee is made up of any three elected officers plus Sgt. of Arms with records)

SPECIAL EVENTS: THE CHRISTMAS AND AWARDS BANQUET

This is one of the largest and most prominent events of the year for the Flying Fez Club. All members attend in Blue Coat Uniform with their wives as well as any guests they wish to bring. This is the last month outgoing officers preside and it finalizes the outgoing Commander's duties by presenting the various awards earned throughout the year by the club members. There is a program of entertainment with dinner, drinks and merrymen, finalizing the past 12 months of the Flying Fez.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

The Commander must appoint a Nominating Committee at the September Business meeting. The Committee's recommended slate is to be read at the October Business Meeting, as well as any additional nominations from the floor added. Then the complete slate of nominated Officers is published and mailed to each member to be voted on by the Flying Fez body at the November Business meeting. All officers serve from January to, and including, December, or until newly elected officers are properly sworn in. Therefore, if there is a Club Business meeting held in January prior to the swearing in ceremony of

the new officers, then the past Commander must waive his right to conduct that meeting designating the newly elected Commander to act on/in his behalf.

DINNER

BANQUET:

This ceremonial induction dinner party is to be held at a date past the induction date of the new Ararat Potentate, which could be in January or February at the discretion of the new Commander. This party is open to all Fez member's wives, friends and Ararat Shrine Members who wish to come and pay respect to the new officers of the Flying Fez. Formal installation is performed by the Potentate or his designee. This event is also one of the most prominent social events starting the new year.
